A. Both the DDI and DDS&T Training Officers have advised us that it is doubtful that they will have any nominations for the National Interdepartmental Seminar either in September or in subsequent runnings.

B. We have received correspondence from Mr. James Beck, Director of the Executive Seminar Center, Kings Point, advising us of the progress made at the Center during the past year. Mr. Beck is being reassigned to Washington to take over the development of a second Center to be established on the West Coast. In addition to a detailed report on the activities at Kings Point, Mr. Beck appended a memo from Mr. John Macy, Chairman of the Civil Service Commission to President Johnson in which he told the President of the success of the Kings Point enterprise. The President responded by urging Government Agencies to continue to send people for this training but to be highly selective in their choice of personnel. This paper is presently being circulated.

C. Colonel [redacted] Commandant of the Defense Intelligence School, was advised that CIA would have only one nominee for the 7 September Advanced Intelligence Course. Colonel [redacted] indicated that if at the last minute we had other qualified candidates he would be quite willing to consider them.

D. We have received a memorandum from [redacted], Executive Director, NPIC requesting that the orders on Mr. [redacted] who is scheduled for training at [redacted] be so written as to enable him to live and draw allowances [redacted] This will result in an expenditure of \$2500 more than if he were PCS'd [redacted] They justified their request on their desire to have Mr. [redacted] where adequate housing is available. E. A hurry-up request from BPAM to approve [redacted]
for Systems Analysis Training at The University of California
was approved by Colonel White. [redacted] who is still a Career
Trainee was processed in quick order by the External Training
Branch in order that he could depart the Washington area by 14
August. This particular training program appears in part to be
a response to a 15 July Presidential Directive "that selected
personnel among the Departments and Agencies making up the U. S.
Intelligence Community be provided specialized training in advanced
studies at a university center or centers where systems thinking
and systems skills are understood and imparted, and which at the
same time possess adequate background in conventional bibliography
and other more classical approaches to literature and information
management." The Office of Training has not been put on distribu-
tion for this Directive. [redacted] who is not aware of
the [redacted] action had called me earlier for background which he
might use in making a recommendation as to how the Agency might
comply with this Directive. He agreed to send me a copy. The
enrollment of [redacted] in the Systems Analysis Course, run
jointly by the Institute for Defense Analysis and the University
of Maryland, certainly falls within the scope of the Directive
for which a progress report is required by 1 October.
