25 YEAR RE-REVIEW

1. While debriefing [redacted] OS, about the Armed Forces Staff College, I was interested to note that the National Security Agency students receive \$9.00 per diem and the Agency for International Development students \$2.50 per diem. Our students receive \$6.00 per diem. He expressed the hope that future students could attend with their families. He felt that wives would be a definite asset. This thought has often been expressed by our returnees from the College. Today, [redacted] ORR, who attended the winter 1964 class, called to find out if the students "still had to go TDY." He plans to nominate one of his employees. Whether the family goes was a determining factor in the nomination.

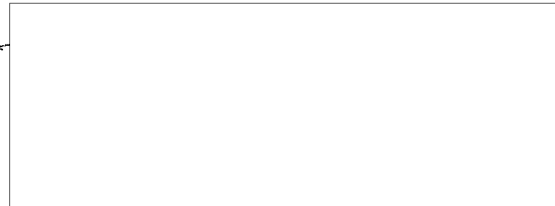
