C. Mr. Mel Wade of the Civil Service Commission advised us on 22 December that the Office of Career Development was going ahead with plans for presenting the Planning, Programming and Budgeting Courses referred to in our 17 December report. They hope to offer, by mid-January, the two-day orientation and by early February, the three-weeks Management Systems Course, geared to the needs of the civilian agencies as compared to the DOD Monterey Course which is Defense oriented. He was pleased with our response to his query for a "guestimate" as to our requirements. I reaffirmed our early comment that our figures were estimates only and that our true requirements could well exceed our estimate. He acknowledged this. We will now go to the Agency components with a request for specific requirements.
