4. A German 103 class ended on 1 July with 4 students. A Russian 102 class ended on 16 July with

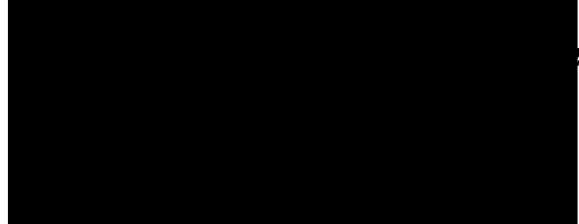
