MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Medical Services

SUBJECT : OMS Actions on IG Survey of the OMS

Report on Recommendation No. 11

1. Recommendation No. 11 states that the Deputy Director for Support develop effective procedures for keeping the Office of Personnel informed concerning employees who have been injured, who are ill, or who have died, as well as employees and dependents who are medically evacuated from overseas.

2. The undersigned met with [ ] Deputy Director of Personnel for Special Programs, on 16 September 1968 to discuss the above recommendation. Discussion was also held with [ ] Deputy Chief, Personal Affairs Branch, Office of Personnel. [ ] indicated he had no complaints regarding the timeliness or areas of reporting to the Office of Personnel. [ ] gave much the same opinion. [ ] did indicate that he would appreciate notification as soon as possible of medical evacuation cases. I have advised [ ] that I will arrange for such notification with the Field Support Staff.

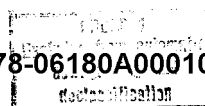
