1. CIA's authority and responsibility for conducting training in counterinsurgency are contained in _______ 25X1A March 1962. These directives require that CIA train its personnel in the following aspects of Counterinsurgency: a) history of subversive insurgency movements; b) Agency tactics and techniques to counter insurgency; c) contributions of other U.S. agencies to counter insurgency; d) the threat posed by Communist party ideology and organizational practices to U.S. national security; e) situation-assessment and evaluation of overseas internal security situations; f) program planning and implementation for countering insurgency; and g) study of the Overseas Internal Defense Policy Paper. The directives also require that CIA offer training as appropriate to selected foreign nationals.

2. While the principal Agency course in Counterinsurgency is the 23X1A which is compulsory for all Career Trainess entering on duty with the Clandestine Services, most elements noted in paragraph 1 above are covered in varying degrees in seventeen additional courses offered by the Agency.
