We have received the working draft of the proposed Chapter 7-1 of the Federal Personnel Manual pertaining to training enclosed in your letter of 10 November 1958 requesting review and comment. We appreciate the opportunity of reviewing the proposed new training Chapter (FPM).

As the Commission is aware, this Agency is presently seeking exemption from certain portions of the Government Employees Training Act of 1955 (P. L. 84-507). The Agency has requested the Bureau of the Budget to secure an appropriate Presidential exemption and it is our understanding that the matter was presented to the Commission for comment. In view of our request for Presidential exemption, we believe it unnecessary to furnish any detailed comment at this time.
