NO NEW SAM INSTALLATIONS HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AND NO THER SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED. NO SIGNIFICANT MILITARY ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED IN THE VERY SMALL PORTION OF SOUTH CHINA WHICH IS COVERED ON THE PHOTOGRAPHY. PART 3. 1. NINE OF THE 24 DEPLOYED ICBM COMPLEXES ARE COVERED ON THIS MISSION. KOSTROMA AND YURYA ARE COMPLETELY COVERED ON CLEAR PHOTOGRAPHY. - 9. CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES OF THE MOSKVA/CHEREPOVETS BEER CAN STRUCTURE AND AN OBJECT ATOP THE PLATFORM MAY BE A "BACK-TWIN" (MYTISHCHI TYPE) ANTENNA UNDER CONSTRUCTION.
