

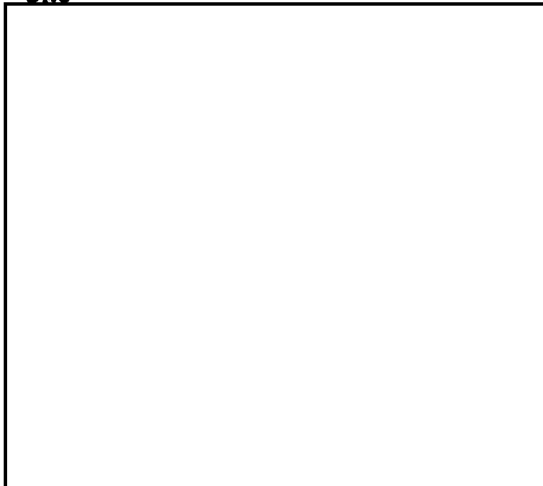

CITE NPIC 2954  
 CONTINUING ANALYSIS OF MISSION 1045-1, 25 JAN 68, REVEALS A  
 NEWLY IDENTIFIED SAM SITE, LAN-CHOU SAM SITE C25-2, CHINA, AT  
 35-54-05N 103-16-21E, APPROXIMATELY 26 NM SW OF LAN-CHOU. THERE  
 ARE 6 FENCED LAUNCH POSITIONS, EACH CONTAINING A PROBABLE MISSILE  
 TRANSPORTER. THE GUIDANCE AREA CONTAINS A PROBABLE RADAR AND  
 SEVERAL U/I VEHICLES/PIECES OF EQUIPMENT. APPROXIMATELY 36 TENTS  
 AND NUMEROUS U/I OBJECTS ARE OBSERVED IN A SUPPORT AREA LOCATED  
 APPROXIMATELY 800 FEET SOUTHEAST OF THE LAUNCH POSITIONS.  
 ANALYSIS OF PREVIOUS PHOTOGRAPHY INDICATES EVIDENCE OF PRELIMINARY

LAN-CHOU SAM SITE B29-2 (36-03N103-23E), APPROXIMATELY 18 NM TO THE NORTHEAST, IS NOW UNOCCUPIED EXCEPT FOR UNIDENTIFIED OBJECTS IN ONE LAUNCH REVETMENT AND THE GUIDANCE AREA. NO IDENTIFIABLE MISSILE EQUIPMENT IS APPARENT, AND PRACTICALLY ALL TENTS HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM THE SUPPORT AREA. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THE SITE HAS BEEN OBSERVED UNOCCUPIED ON KH PHOTOGRAPHY SINCE IT WAS INITIALLY IDENTIFIED ON [Redacted]
