ANALYSIS OF KH MISSION 1047-1 (24 JUNE 1968) REVEALS A NEW OIL FIELD UNDER DEVELOPMENT LOCATED 17.5 NM SOUTH OF TA-KU, CHINA AT 38 43 OON-117 33 OOE. [REDACTED] REVEALS AN AREA APPROXIMATELY 8 MILES X 14 MILES OF RECLAIMED MARSHLAND CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 20 DISCERNIBLE DERRICKS, NUMEROUS SUMPS AND POSSIBLE FLOW TANKS, EIGHT SMALL TANKS, AND FOUR LARGE TANKS UNDER CONSTRUCTION. A POSSIBLE CRUDE OIL PROCESSING FACILITY IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION. ALSO, OBSERVED ARE NUMEROUS GROUND SCARS THROUGHOUT THE AREA, AND A NUMBER OF PROBABLE WORKER HOUSING UNITS.
