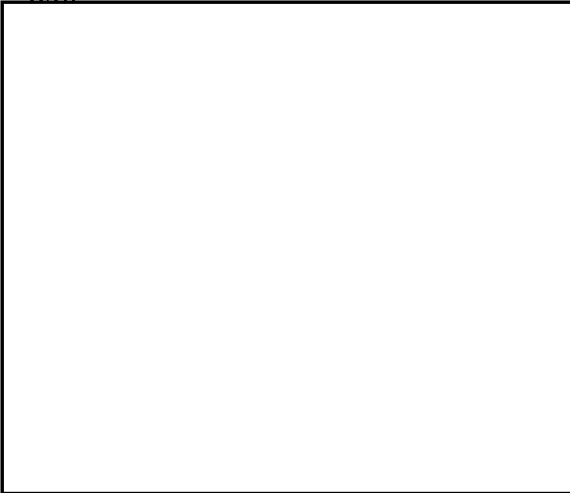

CONTINUING ANALYSIS OF MISSION 1103-1 REVEALS THE FOLLOWING:

1. A PROBABLE CRUISE-MISSILE (SAMLET) SITE IS IDENTIFIED FOR THE FIRST TIME AT ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT. THE SITE IS LOCATED 10.3 NM NE OF ALEXANDRIA (31-19N 030-03E). THE SITE CONSISTS OF TWO PROBABLE LAUNCH POSITIONS (ONE OCCUPIED BY AN UNIDENTIFIED OBJECT, ONE OCCUPANCY UNDETERMINED), TWO PROBABLE CONTROL VANS, FIVE PROBABLE RADAR/ELECTRONIC VANS, THREE PROBABLE MISSILE TRANSPORTERS, ONE LARGE POSSIBLE MISSILE SERVICING TENT, 20-25 PERSONNEL TENTS, AND APPROXIMATELY 15 VEHICLES/PIECES OF EQUIPMENT.

2. THE CONFIGURATION OF THIS SITE IS SIMILAR TO THE SAMLET SITES LOCATED WITHIN THE SOVIET UNION. IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT STYX MISSILE CRATES AND SAMLET EQUIPMENT WERE OBSERVED ON

[REDACTED] IN THE VICINITY OF ALEXANDRIA. ON MISSION [REDACTED] COVERAGE, BOTH THE CRATES AND EQUIPMENT APPEAR TO BE IN THE SAME LOCATION WITH NO MAJOR CHANGE.
