REVEALS AN INCREASE IN THE SUSPECT VIET CONG ACTIVITY FIRST REPORTED ON [Redacted] INSURGENT TYPE ACTIVITY NOW EXTENDS FROM PH PAPHLAM LOEU, CAMBODIA 11-43N 106-19E NE APPROXIMATELY 2 NM TO PH DONG, CAMBODIA. NUMEROUS ROADS AND TRAILS OBSERVED IN THE SUSPECT AREA. PROBABLE PERIMETER DEFENSES CONSISTING OF PROBABLE TRENCHES, FOXHOLES AND AUTOMATIC WEAPONS (AW) EMBLEMMENTS OBSERVED IN THE VICINITY OF THE SUSPECT AREA. A BANK OF PROBABLE SPOIL, WHICH WAS NOT PRESENT ON MISSION

A POSSIBLE UTILITY TRUCK WITH CANVAS COVER PROJECTING OVER THE CAB AND HOOD OBSERVED PARKED JUST SOUTH OF THE ROAD 0.1 NM SW OF PH PAPHLAM LOEU, UTM XT 433957.

2. A SECOND ENTRANCE ROAD INTO THE SUSPECT AREA OBSERVED 0.3 NM SE OF PH DONG AT UTM XT 460987. THE SHADOW OF A POSSIBLE PROPAGANDA BANNER OR SIGN WAS OBSERVED APPROXIMATELY 200 FEET SE OF THIS ENTRANCE ON A ROAD EXTENDING TO THE SOUTH VIETNAM BORDER.
