2. ORIGINAL NEGATIVE:

A. THE EXPOSURE IS ADEQUATE AND THE RESOLUTION IS GOOD.

B. 9R SIDE: MINUS DENSITY DOTS 0.15" FROM AND PARALLEL TO
THE INBOARD EDGE OCCUR EACH 4.52" ALONG THE MAJOR AXIS OF THE
FILM THROUGHOUT THE MISSION. FROM FRAME 1887 THROUGH FRAME 1902

MINOR, ASSORTED CREASES APPEAR PARALLEL TO THE FILM EDGES. ON THE SAME FRAMES THERE IS ALSO A SERIES OF OVAL SHAPED CHEMICAL STAINS EXTENDING FROM ONE EDGE OF THE FILM TO THE OTHER. THESE STAINS ARE ON THE EMULSION SIDE.

C. 9L SIDE: SEVERAL CREASES PARALLEL TO THE MAJOR AXIS OF THE FILM APPEAR ON FRAMES 1904-1907. CHEMICAL STAINS APPROXIMATELY 1" WIDE, EDGE TO EDGE, APPEAR INTERMITTENTLY ON THE EMULSION SIDE OF FRAMES 1901 THROUGH 1907.

D. THERE IS A TOTAL OF 1935 FRAMES ON EACH SIDE OF THIS MISSION.

E. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CAMERA OR PROCESSING MALFUNCTIONS IN EVIDENCE.

3. POSITIVE:

A. PI SUITABILITY IS GOOD. PRINTING AND PROCESSING ARE GOOD.

B. CLOUDS OBSCURE OR IMPAIR APPROXIMATELY 50 PERCENT OF THIS MISSION.
