1963; PROCESSING WAS ACCOMPLISHED BY NAVY PIC.

2. ORIGINAL NEGATIVE:

A. THE EXPOSURE IS ADEQUATE. THE RESOLUTION IS FAIR TO
GOOD.

B. 9R SIDE: FOGGING ALONG THE OUTBOARD EDGE OF THE FORMAT
IS INTERMITTENT THROUGHOUT THE MISSION. FOG IS ALSO APPARENT ALONG
THE LEADING EDGE OF THE FORMAT INTERMITTENTLY IN THE V, 1R, 2R,
3R AND 2L POSITIONS.

C. 9L SIDE: THERE IS A REPAIRED TEAR, BLISTERS, AND 2.0"
LONG CHEMICAL STAIN ON FRAME 608. BLISTERS ARE ALSO NOTED ON
FRAMES 267, 685, 686 AND 1680.

D. BOTH SIDES: THE FILM METERING IS SLIGHTLY ERRATIC THROUGH
OUT THE MISSION. INBOARD EDGE STATIC IS INTERMITTENT THROUGHOUT.

E. THE RESOLUTION IS FAIR DUE TO ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS.
THERE WERE NO MAJOR PROCESSING MALFUNCTIONS. THE LAST TITLED
FRAME ON EACH SIDE IS 1684.

3. POSITIVE:

A. THE PI SUITABILITY IS FAIR TO GOOD DUE TO THE DEGRADED
RESOLUTION OF THE ORIGINAL NEGATIVE, WHICH IS ATTRIBUTED TO CLOUDS
AND HAZE. THE PRINTING AND PROCESSING OF THE POSITIVE IS GOOD.

B. CLOUDS OBSCURE OR DEGRADE 80 PERCENT OF THE MISSION.
