THE SITE IS COMPRISED OF SIX OCCUPIED LAUNCH POSITIONS. THREE
SHEETED MISSILES ON TRANSPORTERS ARE IN STAND-BY POSITION AT
THREE OF THE LAUNCH PADS. EACH OF THE SIX LAUNCHERS IS SHEETED
AND NOT VISIBLE. ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT INCLUDES A FAN SONG RADAR
IN THE CENTRAL GUIDANCE, FOUR PROBABLE VANS AND FIVE POSSIBLE
UNIDENTIFIED TRUCKS.
