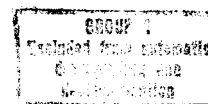

AT 53-04N/158-32E AND CONSISTS OF A SINGLE SECURED AREA CONTAINING
1 CENTRAL CONTROL BUILDING, NUMEROUS UNIDENTIFIED HF ANTENNAS AND
APPROXIMATELY 8 SUPPORT BUILDINGS.

THE SECOND IS LOCATED 2.5 NM NORTH OF PETROPAVLOVSK YELIZOVO
A/F AT 53-12N/158-26E AND CONSISTS OF A LARGE SINGLE SECURED AREA
WHICH CONTAINS 1 LARGE CENTRAL CONTROL BUILDING, AT LEAST 9 RHOMBIC
ANTENNAS, APPROXIMATELY 4 HORIZONTAL DIPOLE ANTENNAS, SEVERAL UN-
IDENTIFIED ANTENNAS AND APPROXIMATELY 20 SUPPORT BUILDINGS.
