EARLY WARNING RADAR SITE LOCATED 4 NAUTICAL MILES NORTHEAST OF NARYAN MAR AIRFIELD AT 67-39-50N 53-10-00E, IDENTIFIED FROM CONTINUING SCAN OF MISSION 4006.
