

Two newly identified revetted circular areas, measuring 170 feet in diameter and 650 feet apart, are located on the east side of Pruzhany MRBM Complex SAM Site B-10. Each area is apparently drive-through. This activity was present on photography of when

the SA-2 Site was first observed.

SA-2 SAM Site B-10 appears to be fully equipped with launchers and guidance and support equipment.

SA-3 SAM Site B-10A is located 1.5 nautical miles north-northeast of SA-2 SAM Site B-10.




FIGURE 1. LARGE REVETTED CIRCULAR AREAS, PRUZHANY MRBM COMPLEX SAM SITE B-10, USSR
