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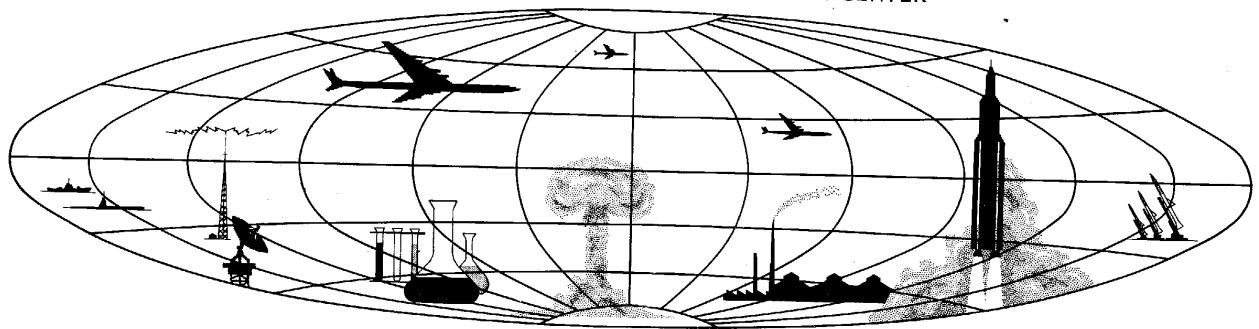
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PREFACE

This Mission Coverage Index (MCI) lists targets of intelligence interest in China, India, and Tibet covered by aerial photographic material from Mission 3227, dated 29 September 1963. Items in the compilation are arranged in three sections:

Section I provides summary information for a) newly identified targets, b) previously reported targets which show a change, and c) all targets showing order of battle information.

Section II provides a listing of those targets which reflect no change in facilities from previous target description. The mission number shown on the photo reference line (e.g. NAC 9000) refers to the MCI which contains the most adequate description of that target. Military installations where no order of battle can be determined are listed under this section.

Section III provides a listing of those targets which could be identified but not interpreted.

All three sections are arranged 1) by country, 2) within a country by subject, 3) within a subject by WAC area, and 4) within a WAC area by coordinates reading from south to north and from west to east.

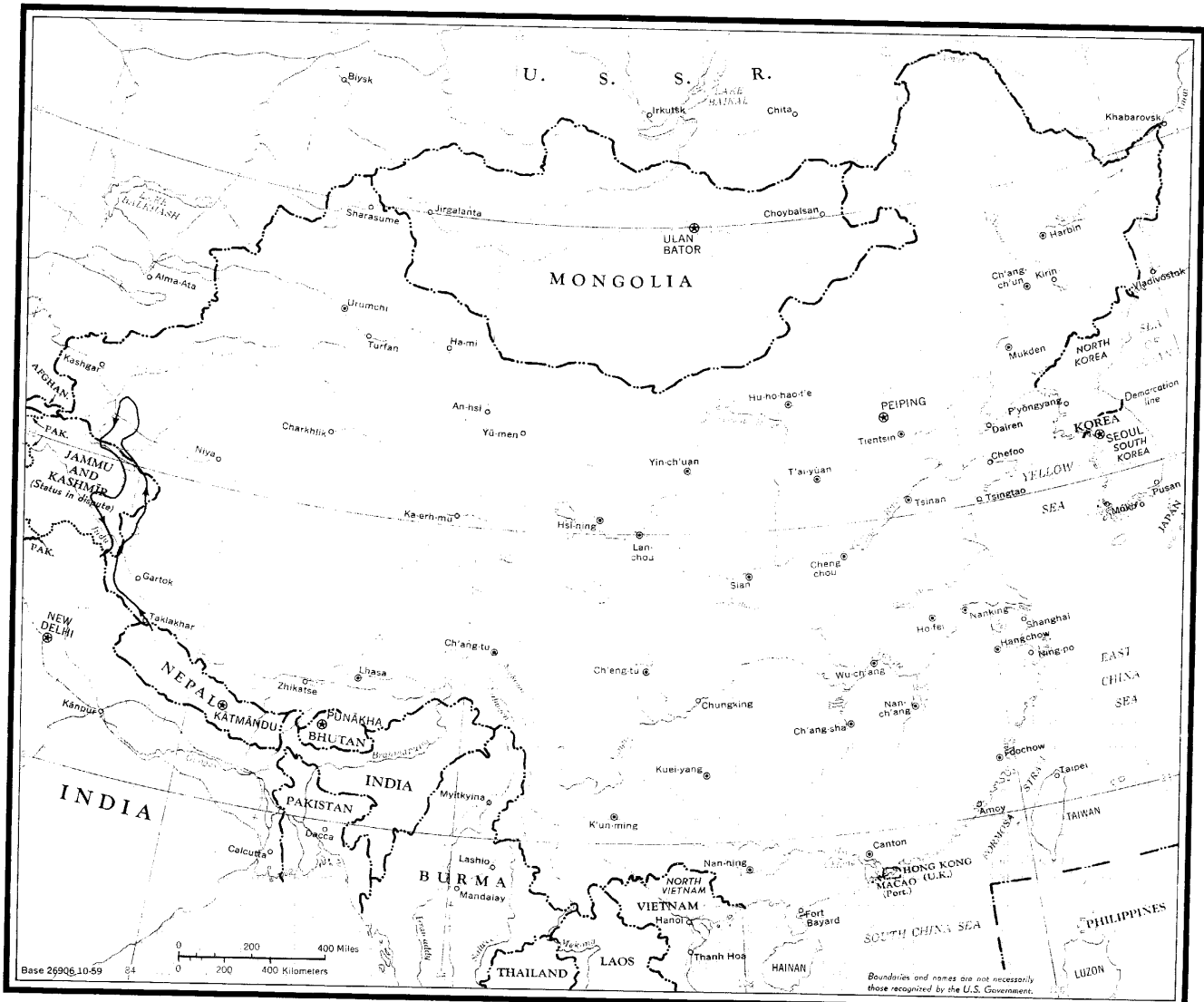
For the convenience of the user, a subject index to all targets has been included following Section III. Targets in the subject index are listed 1) by category, 2) by country within each category, and 3) alphabetically by place name within each country. An explanation of column headings and photo reference data used in presenting the information is contained in the appendix.

The user of this MCI is cautioned that the scan of photography was accomplished in a relatively short time and often without the aid of precise analytical and mensural techniques commonly employed in detailed photographic analysis. Consequently, although the information presented herein is essentially accurate, additional, detailed analysis may somewhat alter portions of the information.

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## APPENDIX

EXPLANATION OF COLUMN HEADINGS  
AND PHOTO REFERENCES

## COLUMN HEADINGS

City, Installation -- This column contains the name of the city or town nearest the installation, followed by the name of the installation. If the name of the installation is not known, it is titled according to its function. Where appropriate, the city and installation names are followed by a capsule description.

Coordinates -- Coordinates are referenced to the SW corner of the minute square. When the subject installation covers a wide area, coordinates are given for the approximate center of the installation.

WAC -- This column provides the World Aeronautical Chart number for the area in which the subject installation lies.

Installation Numbers -- This column is divided into two subcolumns. The first subcolumn lists, when known, the BE installation number assigned to the installation. The second subcolumn lists the installation number assigned by NPIC. Installation numbers, when used to reference an item, should be prefixed by the appropriate WAC number, since installation numbers are repeated from WAC to WAC. For example, there is an NPIC target number 0432-1 and an NPIC target number 0433-1. In each instance, the NPIC installation number is 1, but the installations appear on different WAC charts.

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#### PHOTO REFERENCE DATA

The photo reference data indicates the frame(s) on which the installation appears.

#### CONDITIONS AFFECTING PHOTOGRAPHY

Following the photo reference data, symbols indicate conditions which affect the appearance of the installation on the photography. The symbols are: C (clear); SC (scattered clouds); HC (heavy clouds); SC-HC (scattered-to-heavy clouds); H (haze); CS (cloud shadow); D (darkness); SD (semidarkness); O (obliquity); S (snow); and PQ (poor image quality).

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
