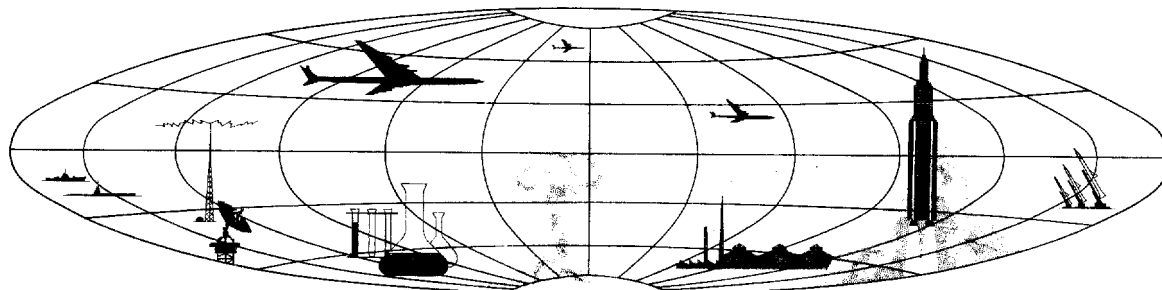

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Kedainiai Possible SAM Site B10-3 is located 11 nm ESE of Kedainiai, USSR, in a cleared, level area. The site is singly deployed and is 12.2 nm SE of Kedainiai Airfield SAM Site A01-2. This SA-3 site was first identified on KEYHOLE photography of [REDACTED] on which it appears under construction.

First evidence of the site appeared on the photography of [REDACTED]. The presence of the site can be negated on [REDACTED] photography. 1/ The site was cloud covered on KEYHOLE coverage between these dates. 2-5/

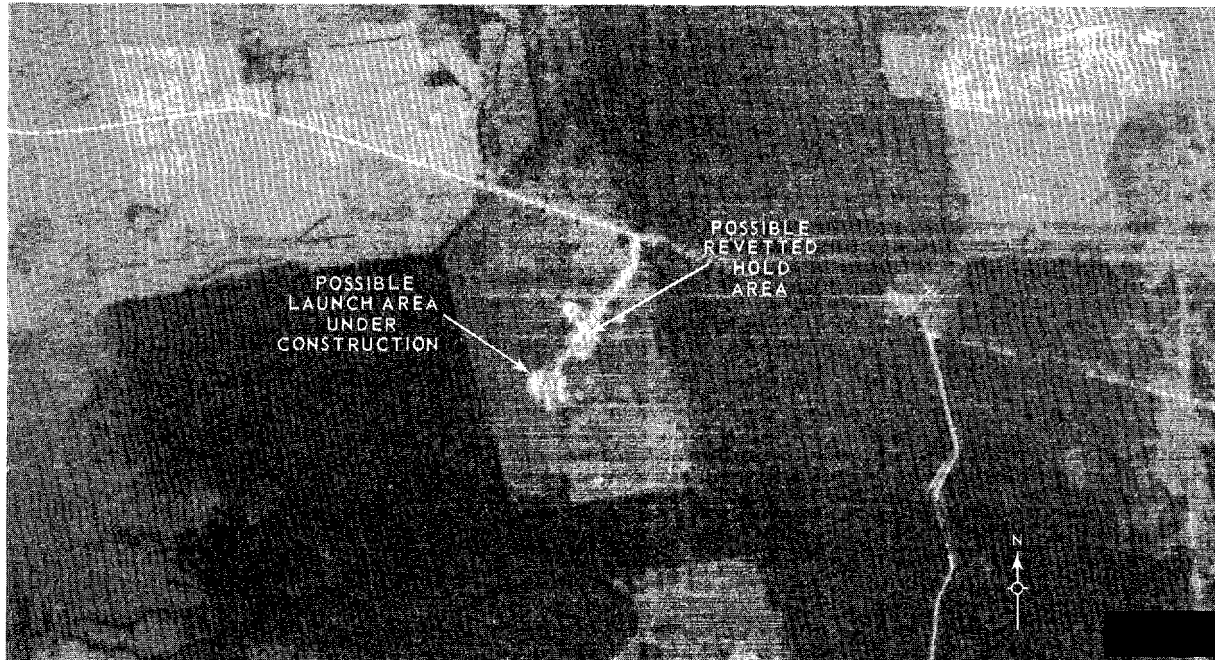
ADDITIONAL REFERENCES

The only discernible components of the site are a possible launch area under construction and a possible revetted hold area (Figure 1). No equipment is in evidence. Because the site is in an early stage of construction, its configuration and exact orientation are undeterminable; however, it is oriented generally SW.
