



BEHIND THE PIER ARE 5 TANK TRUCKS, ONE BOXCAR, ONE TRUCK-MOUNTED DITCH DIGGER, ONE EMPTY FLAT-BED WAGON, 4 CRANES, ONE CRANE WITHOUT A BOOM, APPROXIMATELY 15 OTHER TRUCKS, NUMEROUS PILES OF LUMBER, AND APPROXIMATELY 24 LARGE CABLE REELS. ONE TRUCK-MOUNTED DITCH DIGGER, LOADED ON A LOWBOY TRAILER IS ON THE HIGHWAY LEAVING THE PORT AREA.
