




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PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1c (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the Production Center 1P1c.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (II) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF ARMY BARRACKS, STAZHISKA.

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SUMMARY

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


FIGURE 3. ARMY BARRACKS, STAZHISKA.

A small army barracks area covering approximately 120 acres is located in the eastern portion of Stazhiska immediately north of the rail line (Figure 1). The barracks area contains (Figures 2 and 3) three multistory barracks, two administration buildings, five storage buildings, three support buildings, and one motor vehicle maintenance building.

installation is located ap-

proximately 3 kilometers (km) southwest of the barracks area. The installation is rail served and contains nine buildings.

The barracks area probably serve the Lvov Training Area located 5 km north. The installations were covered by KEYHOLE missions between and showed no apparent change.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

The installation is rail served but the barracks area is not.

Road Service

Both installations are served by all-weather roads.

Administrative and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains three multistory barracks, two multistory administration buildings, five storage buildings, and three support buildings.

Ammunition Storage Area

Area F contains four buried ammunition bunkers.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains two motor vehicle storage buildings, 80 by 30 feet and 160 by 30 feet, one 70- by 35-foot motor vehicle maintenance building, and one support building.

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Area T2 is a small rail-served storage area of an unknown type containing approximately nine unidentified buildings. Whether or not the area is military cannot be determined.

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FIGURE 2. ARMY BARRACKS, STAZHISKA,
