1. It is hereby requested that the necessary arrangements be made to return two [redacted] Chip Comparators [redacted] as soon as possible. The purpose of returning these instruments is to perform the necessary modifications to make them operationally reliable. 25X1

2. Because of the delicate nature of these instruments, it is necessary that they be shipped [redacted] by direct air-ride van without any off loading or additional handling. 25X1

3. The instruments have already been properly packed and prepared for shipment by a [redacted] factory technician and are ready for immediate shipment. In addition to the basic [redacted] chassis, the following supplemental equipment or parts will have to be shipped with each machine: 2 each metal skins (covers), lighting assembly, optical microscope assembly, right hand stage assembly and electronic rack with 2 counters, control panels, synchronizer, vacuum pump. The interferometers, consisting of the optical and electronic assemblies, for both machines have already been shipped [redacted] and will be returned with the machines on completion of the modifications. 25X1
