4. ACTION TAKEN: References a and b have been reviewed and found not to comprehend the customer's requirements for this research. Arrangements have been made to discuss the reoriented objectives of this project. The following guidelines have been determined:
 - a. A comprehensive evaluation of existing contact printers and contact printing techniques should be performed and documented.
 - b. Other methods should be devised, breadboarded and evaluated.
 - c. One primary objective is to determine the technique which provides maximum fidelity of duplication.
 - d. A second primary objective is to precisely relate the performance and potential economy of all competitive systems.
