DAILY REPORT

SUBJECT: US Reconnaissance Activity Over Cuba

1. Today's Schedule

- a. Missions: One BRASS KNOB in the morning.
- b. Purpose : Coverage of priority targets at eastern end of Cuba.
- c. Weather : Broken sky with 5/8 cloud cover over western and central Cuba; scattered clouds 4/8 or less over eastern Cuba.
- d. IPIR due: 15 February 1963.

2. Yesterday's Activity

- a. Missions flown : Two BRASS KNOB missions over western and central Cuba. Pilots estimate 85% and 50% coverage, respectively, of scheduled targets.
- b. IPIR due: 14 February 1963.
- c. Reaction: No significant Cuban air defense reaction noted.

3. Bloc Shipping in Cuban Ports

- a. Number : 3 tankers, 1 passenger, 26 dry cargo, total 30.
- b. Dry cargo ships photographed: 25 of those in port, 2 still in-bound to Cuba.
- c. CIA has received the photographs of 14 of the dry-cargo ships.

4. General Comments

Two BRASS KNOB missions were originally scheduled for today. As of 0400, 13 February, the mission that was to cover targets in western Cuba had been cancelled because of adverse cloud conditions.

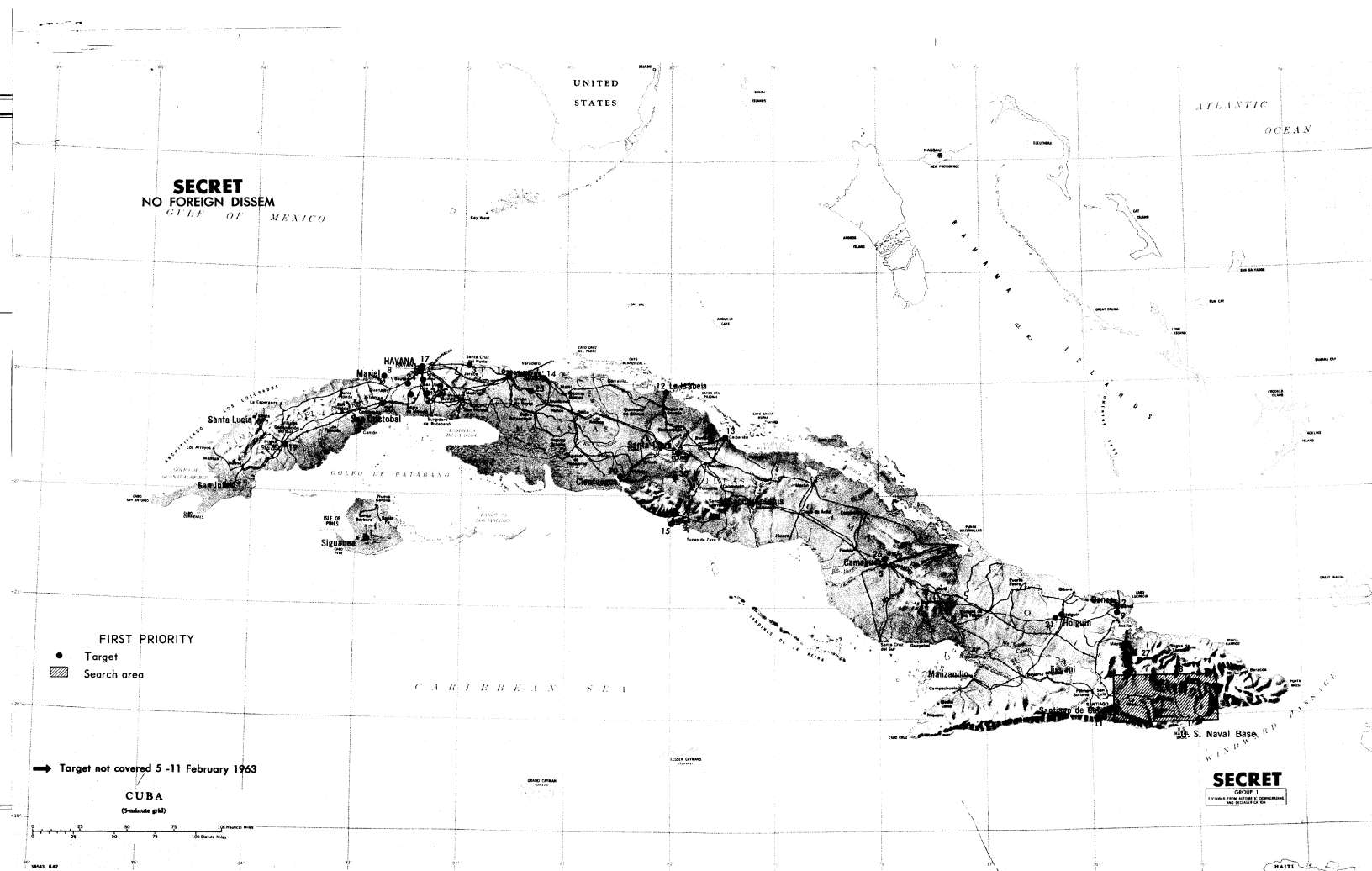
