SUBJECT: Comments on Development Objectives for a Color Control Cell

2. A principle concern of APSD is the unanswered questions regarding the ultimate utility of the proposed Color Control Cell. Such questions arise as:

- a. What types of experiments are planned therein?
- b. Do these experiments justify building a Color Control Cell or could/should they be conducted in present facilities?
- c. Does the Center have available qualified personnel who will conduct these experiments?
- d. Who will be responsible for operation of the Color Control Cell?

It is recommended that first order of business of the contractor selected for this project be directed toward the above questions. Much experimentation planned for the Color Control Cell probably will not require an elaborate facility. However, experiments which involve the human aspects and the environment probably will require a controlled and flexible environment. The APSD recommends that the above items be emphasized in the Development Objectives and throughout the contract discussions.
