3. In answer to my request for a list of those items which he would like to see changed or improved on a new light table, offered the following suggestions:	STAT
a. Change the hand crank so that the handle moves freely relative to the crank, thereby reducing the friction between the handle and the operator's hand. (It was noted that shop had altered some of the light table handles satisfactor by including sleeve bearings.)	. ₁₁₃ 87A7

- b. Improve the cranking handle brake mechanism.
- c. Improve the microscope carriage movement by reducing the friction between the carriage and its ways.
- d. Make the microscope support more rigid in order to allow maintaining the tolerance limits of the mount.
- e. Make all adjusting screws, etc., of the captive type in order to preclude their easy removal and loss.
- 4. It was also ascertained that IAS, due to its particular method of operation, did not require a cranking speed ration step-up but would probably have a future need for an electric motor drive on the cranking mechanism.
