1. Syria

A. Damascus Airfield: 40 aircraft (5 meteor, 1 probable meteor, 4 C-47 type, 2 C-54 type, 28 unidentified single engine prop straight wing conventional gear).

B. Damascus Military Camp, 2.8 miles NNE of Damascus: 19 possible tanks or self propelled guns, approximately 35 vehicles. Facilities include 9 vehicle sheds, 3 admin buildings, 27 quonset huts, 21 barracks, 2 large shop buildings, approximately 10 small buildings. All the camp is fenced.

C. Damascus Probable Ammo Storage Area: 9 probable FA guns and 9 probable trucks reported.

D. Military Installation 10 miles West Damascus: Approximately 50 vehicles reported.

E. No information available on the following airfields and installations: Dumeir, Sahl Es Shara Airfield, Quteifi.

F. Security Area, Probable Barracks Area, 1 mile North Nebek: No activity reported.

G. Airfield reported at 3323N 3607E does not exist at these coordinates or in vicinity.

2. Jordan

A. Jenin Airfields: No activity reported.

B. No information available on the following installations: Mafraq Airfields new and old, Amman Airfield, Ariha Area, Mafraq Complex.
