MEMORANDUM FOR: Commanding Officer, U. S. Navy Photographic Interpretation Center

SUBJECT : NPIC Requirement for Vault Space

1. On several occasions you have offered to make vault and storage space available to the Center for the storage of selected materials. Our classified film holdings have been inventoried. We could use 3 film vaults, 20x20 feet in size since we have about 9000 cans of film which must be stored elsewhere to provide necessary expansion space in the Stewart Building until such time as we are able to occupy our new facility tentatively scheduled for October 1962.

2. In addition, we could use about 400 square feet of secure but not necessarily vaulted space which has the temperature and humidity control required for the storage of photographic films, paper and chemicals.

3. It should be noted that 3 - 4 NPIC personnel would require access to these areas during working hours. Only infrequently would access be necessary during off-duty hours.

4. We greatly appreciate your offer and hope that the necessary arrangements for occupancy of this space may be completed as soon as possible.
