SUBJECT : CHAIC Requirements for Work by HPIC

1. It is our desire to provide the best possible service to CHAIC, consistent with other community requirements. It is essential therefore that we have a clear understanding of how CHAIC requirements are to be processed and handled.

2. There are basically five types of output from HPIC of interest to CHAIC:

- a. Immediate readout reports
- b. Detailed reports for other than CHAIC
- c. Informal assists
- d. Briefings
- e. Detailed reports for CHAIC

3. On items a and b I assume that there is no problem. Presumably the various members of CHAIC see our formal reports through regular distribution channels.

4. Item c refers to relatively simple requests for information such as the date of most recent coverage of a certain item, whether or not a certain feature was observed, or similar tasks requiring less than four PI hours and not requiring a coordinated HPIC answer. To provide this service there should be a direct connection between the interested CHAIC group and a PI element in the HPIC facility. For simplicity and convenience and

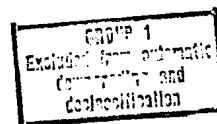

follow parallel treatment for other agencies, we have assigned responsibility for each GMAIC group to the departmental element in HPIC corresponding to the parent organization of the Chairman of that group. (see enclosure 1) When the working group concerned has a requirement in this category the Chairman should contact the HPIC element indicated.

5. Item d refers to any briefings for groups outside HPIC, varying from brief summaries to detailed work sessions. We hope in the future that we can add to the number of such briefings as it is an appropriate medium for satisfying a number of analysts' requirements, but at the present time our capabilities are somewhat limited. Briefings for GMAIC can be arranged by direct contact with the element indicated in enclosure 1. If a major effort is involved in the briefing it will be necessary for the HPIC element involved to arrange scheduling and participation through the Director's office.

6. Item e refers to detailed reports for GMAIC. The only current project in this category is JB 118-62 (Black Book), a major project. Such projects must be submitted in writing and processed through our Advisory Committee for assignment of priority (for obviously critical work we will, of course, start work while the project is processing). We have a standard requirement format and requirements flow procedure because we have learned from experience that detailed projects must be very carefully defined if work is to proceed efficiently. The coordinating elements listed in enclosure 1 will assist working group chairmen in formulating and processing requirements.

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7. The above comments pertain only to the mechanics of handling requirements of various types, whereas the critical aspect of interest to you is, of course, production in support of the requirement. If at any time it appears to any of your working group Chairmen that, after due consideration of other priorities, a requirement is not being met satisfactorily, it is requested that they contact the Assistant for Operations

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8. Your concurrence in the above procedures is requested. In addition, it might be helpful if we scheduled a briefing for your working group Chairmen to familiarize them with work in progress here and relationship to their own work.
