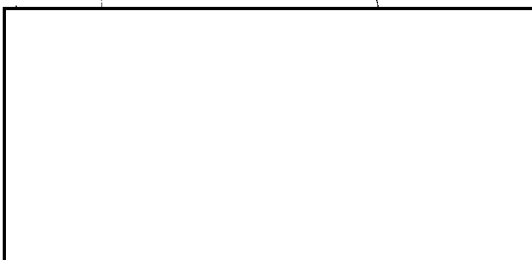

We have considered your letter of 24 July 1970 from [redacted]

work until that audit is completed.

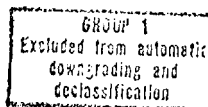
Your offer of a fixed price contract will be considered after
