SUBJECT : Transfer of Minicard Equipment

Subject: Minicard Equipment

1. The SS-2A Minicard Selector requested by reference, and which we had verbally agreed to declare surplus and transfer to DIA, is no longer surplus to our needs. A number of circumstances have changed which have necessitated this revision of our original position. These include:

a) Our request volume has increased to the point where we feel we must have a backup machine if we are to provide reliable and timely service to our customers. (We have only one other selector.)

b) We had thought we would be able to obtain a selector which is now in storage at Eastman Kodak Company. We have found, however, that it would be considerably more expensive to obtain and install this machine than to rehabilitate our SS-2A Selector. Current economy measures have forced us to rule out any thought of obtaining Kodak's selector.

2. The CD2A Minicard Document Camera, also requested by reference, continues to be surplus to our needs, and I have asked the Office of Logistics to transfer it to you without further delay. I understand they have already been in touch with your people to make arrangements for pick-up.

3. [ ] informs me that you and [ ] would like to visit NPIC; I would be delighted to show you our facility and suggest you contact my office [ ] to arrange a suitable time.

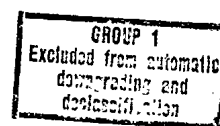
