MEMORANDUM FOR THE DEPUTY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: Aircraft Attrition Rates by Area

Attrition rates recently quoted for the heavily defended area around Hanol and Halphong have caused comment because the area involved wasn't stated. CIA says that attack sorties in that. area had a loss rate of 3.7% in the first four months of this year; the DPM on Alternative Military Actions, dated 19 May, used a figure of one loss every 40 sortles (i.e., 2.5%). The JCS reaction, I understand, is that the loss rate is only 1%.

The JCS objection is well-taken if the "weavily defended erea" is taken to mean all of Route Packages 5 and 6. The table, using Silverman's new data that cover 1 Oct 1966 through 31 May 1967, shows a rate of 10.8 per thousand (1.00%) for RP's 5 and 6 combined. There has been some random variation but no trend, so that the figure for 1967 along would be about the same. The table shows other rates for comparison.
