SUBJECT: Sino - Soviet Border Study

REFERENCE: Requirement No. OGI/9/63 (Project No. C 181-63)

1. In response to Requirement No. OGI/9/63 (C 181-63), a study was made from available aerial photography of the area within 150 nautical miles of each side of the Sino - Soviet border to list, describe, and plot all identifiable and suspect military installations.

2. The area of interest covered a total of 27 WAC (1:1,000,000) charts. The study was performed on a WAC-by-WAC basis, resulting in a series of annotated WAC overlays showing the significant items of interest within the particular WAC areas.

3. The information on each WAC overlay is further augmented with a list of annotations giving a brief description of significant installations under the general categories of (a) Airfields, (b) Missile Activity, (c) Military Installations, and (d) Unidentified Installations. Photographic enlargements of selected installations also were obtained.

4. The information contained in this study is inclusive of [REDACTED]

5. Forwarded for your retention are a total of 27 annotated WAC overlays (NPIC H-3040, 3276, 3284 thru 3303, 3477 thru 3480 and 3498, copy 1) with corresponding lists of annotations and 5 annotated photographic enlargements (CIA/PID/GMB/P-2989/63 thru P-2993/63, copy 1).
