



Figure 1. SAM SITE 15 NM SSW OF ZAPOROZHYE. DECLASS REVIEW by NGA/DOD

15 nm south-southwest of reference point.

FUNCTION:

One of the sites deployed for the defense of Zaporozhye.

SITE STATUS:

Complete and operational.

LAUNCH FACILITIES:

Six launch revetments with six launchers emplaced.

MISSILES:

Six canvas-covered missiles on trailers in hold revetments.

ELECTRONICS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT:

FRUIT SET radar with associated vans and/or trailers positioned in revetments at center of operations area.
