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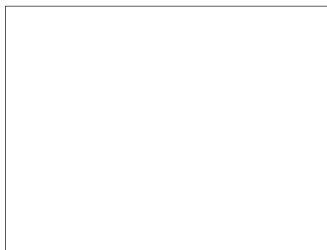

REMARKS:

THE LAUNCH SITE WAS COVERED ON 14 AND 19 MAR, 1, 10, 23, AND 28 APR, AND 2 MAY. ONE OF THE CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT BUILDINGS NEXT TO THE LAUNCH PAD WAS DISMANTLED. LEVELING OF THE APRON AROUND THE LAUNCH PAD WAS APPARENT. TWO NEW BRIDGES WERE UNDER CONSTRUCTION. THE BRIDGES CONNECT THE APRON TO THE NORTH BANK OF THE STREAM, DIVIDING THE LAUNCH SITE. ONE ADIT AND POSSIBLY TWO OTHER ADITS WERE IDENTIFIED FOR THE FIRST TIME ON THE NORTH BANK NEAR THE LAUNCH PAD. CONSTRUCTION, PRINCIPALLY LINING THE UNDERGROUND TUNNELS AND ROOMS WITH CONCRETE, WAS OBSERVED AT THE TWO LARGE ADITS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED IN [Redacted]

REMARKS:

ON 5 APR MOST OF THE CONCRETE PAD WAS CLEARLY VISIBLE. SEVERAL MOUNDS OF UNIDENTIFIED MATERIAL WERE ON AND ADJACENT TO THE PAD. ALSO ON 5 APR A TRENCH WAS OBSERVED IN THE LEVELED AREA IMMEDIATELY EAST OF THE PAD. THE SOUTH END OF THE TRENCH APPEARED TO TERMINATE AT A SMALL WHITE BOX-LIKE OBJECT, WHILE THE NORTH END OF THE TRENCH TERMINATED AT THE NORTH END OF THE BUILT-UP LEVELLED AREA. THE TRENCH WAS NOT PRESENT ON 1 APR AND HAD BEEN BACKFILLED BY 27 APR. IT DOES NOT COINCIDE WITH OR CONNECT TO ANY PREVIOUSLY KNOWN PROPELLANT LINES.

ON 27 APR THE ENTIRE LAUNCH SITE SHOWED A VERY CLEAN APPEARANCE, WITH ALL THE ROADS, THE CONCRETE PAD, AND THE LAUNCH APRON ALL CLEARLY DEFINED. ON THE PAD AND LAUNCH APRON WERE AT LEAST 23 REGULARLY SPACED MOUNDS OF UNIDENTIFIED MATERIAL.

THE AREA COULD ONLY BE IDENTIFIED ON 28 MAR AND 2 MAY. THE
LAUNCH PAD AND APRON WERE MOSTLY CLEAR OF CAMOUFLAGE MATERIAL.
HOWEVER NO VEHICLES OR PIECES OF EQUIPMENT WERE DISCERNIBLE IN
THE LAUNCH AREA. ONE CARGO TRUCK WAS OBSERVED IN THE PERSONNEL
HOUSING AND SUPPORT AREA ON 28 APR.

3.3 NM SSE OF WU-CHAI MAIN SUPPORT BASE.
THE NEWLY IDENTIFIED POSSIBLE MISSILE SUPPORT FACILITY CONSISTS
OF A LARGE CLERESTORY BUILDING APPROXIMATELY 219 FEET LONG AND
41 FEET HIGH AND SEVERAL SUPPORT BUILDINGS THAT HAVE BEEN
CONSTRUCTED NEAR AN EXISTING VILLAGE SINCE 1971. THE
CLERESTORY BUILDING WAS NOT PRESENT IN JUN 71 AND WAS FIRST
OBSERVED UNDER CONSTRUCTION ON 1 FEB 72. IMPROVED ROADS
CONNECT THE POSSIBLE MISSILE SUPPORT FACILITY TO THE WU-CHAI
MAIN SUPPORT BASE AND THE LAUNCH SITES. THE FACILITY IS
CONNECTED BY BURIED CONDUIT TO A WATER SUPPLY POINT 2.1 NM TO
THE NNW. BUILDINGS ADJACENT TO THE LARGE CLERESTORY BUILDING
INCLUDE AT LEAST EIGHT BARRACKS, THREE MESSHALLS, AND 14
SUPPORT BUILDINGS.

THE HEADQUARTERS/ADMINISTRATION PART OF THE SUPPORT FACILITY HAS BEEN TARGETED SEPARATELY AS CHIEN-SHUI SSM HQ GENERAL (BE [REDACTED] AT 23-38-55N 102-45-45E). THE AREA WAS OBSERVED ON 14, 19, AND 28 MAR; 1, 10, AND 28 APR, AND 2 MAY. NO MISSILE GROUND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT WAS DISCERNIBLE. THE TWO LONG OBJECTS AT THE NE EDGE OF THE FACILITY THAT WERE REPORTED AS SUSPECT CSS-2 MISSILE TRANSPORTERS IN [REDACTED] WERE NO LONGER PRESENT. THEY PROBABLY WERE LARGE STACKS OF LUMBER AND BUILDING MATERIALS FOR NEW BUILDINGS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA. APPROXIMATELY 15 NEW, SINGLE-STORY BUILDINGS WERE UNDER CONSTRUCTION. MOST OF THE BUILDINGS APPEARED TO BE FOR HOUSING AND GENERAL STORAGE.

ON 8 MAY, 11 LARGE TENTS, FIVE SMALL TENTS, AND A VEHICLE PARK HAD BEEN SET UP NEAR THREE LARGE STORAGE BUILDINGS AT THE NORTHERN EDGE OF THE HOUSING AND SUPPORT AREA. INCLUDED AMONG THE VEHICLES WERE THREE CHERRY PICKERS, A TRUCK-MOUNTED CRANE, AND SEVERAL CARGO TRUCKS. THIS ENCAMPMENT WAS PROBABLY RELATED TO THE MISSILE TRAINING EXERCISE INVOLVING WARHEAD MATING OBSERVED ON THE PAD AT LAUNCH SITE A ON THE SAME DAY.

ON THE HILLSIDE SW OF THE MISSILE ASSEMBLY AND CHECKOUT AREA, FIVE BARRACKS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AND WALLS HAVE BEEN ERECTED FOR TWO MESSHALLS, A SIXTH BARRACKS, AND ANOTHER BUILDING. BUILDING CONSTRUCTION WAS ALSO EVIDENT IN A RAVINE JUST TO THE SOUTH. SEVEN PROBABLE NEW-TYPE PROPELLANT TRUCKS REMAINED IN THE MISSILE ASSEMBLY AND CHECKOUT AREA.

BETWEEN 20 AND 29 MAR, A TRENCH SEGMENT WAS ADDED SE OF THE SILO CONNECTING TWO EXISTING TRENCHES. THE TRENCH NOW LEADS FROM THE PROBABLE WATER DELUGE TANK TO A POINT ADJACENT TO NINE BARRACKS/SUPPORT BUILDINGS EAST OF THE SILO. BETWEEN 20 APR AND 8 MAY, A BUILDING AND ANOTHER STRUCTURE, POSSIBLY A CONCRETE BATCH PLANT, WERE CONSTRUCTED ON THE WESTERN EDGE OF THE SILO. THE PROBABLE WATER DELUGE TANK WAS PARTIALLY BACKFILLED, AND WORK HAD PROGRESSED ON THREE LEVELED AREAS ON THE RIDGE JUST WEST OF THE SILO.
