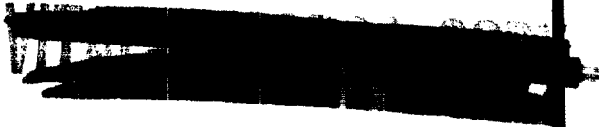

Location: 1.8 nm S of Tiksi Airfield West
 Function: HF DF
 Status: Complete
 Activity: Active, roads cleared of snow
 Support Components: A rectangular central control building; 2 buildings are on the access road, just outside the outer ring.
 Security: Low outer-ring fence
 Vegetation & Terrain: Surrounding terrain flat and barren
 Site Support Facilities: Large support area containing approximately 24 buildings is approximately 1 nm E.
 Associated Facilities: A Fishbone HF receiving facility is 1 nm NE and a Rhombic HF transmitting site is 1.5 nm SW.
 Unusual Features: 2 probable snow fences are on W side of site and central control area is very cluttered.
