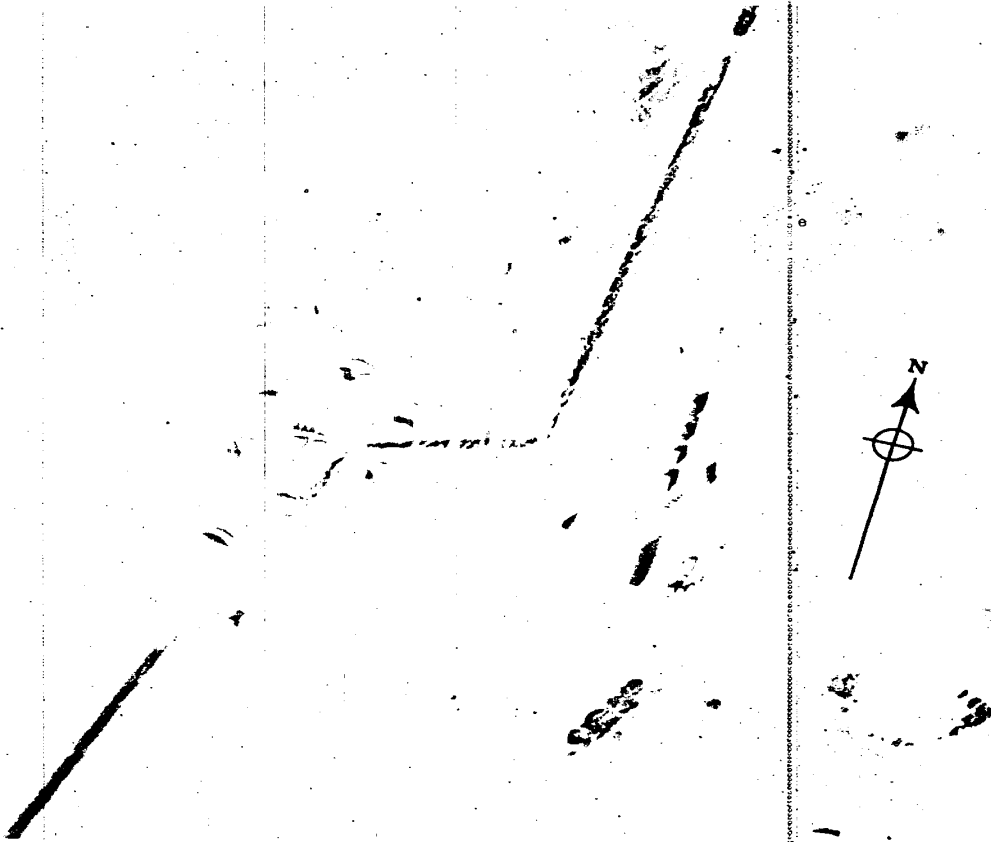


Figure 1. SAM SITE 11.5 NM NW OF KAZAN.

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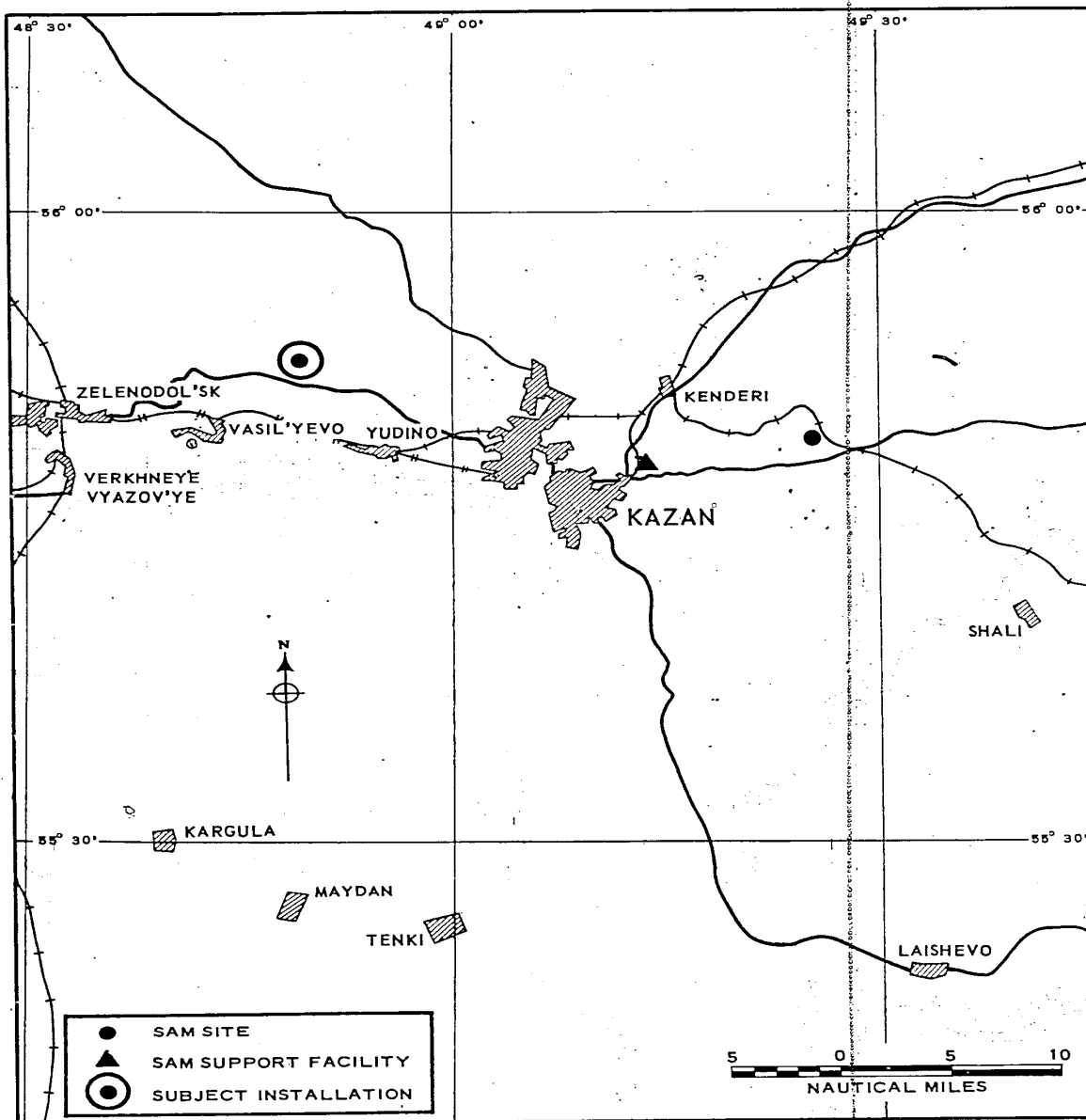


FIGURE 2. SAM SITES AND SUPPORT FACILITIES IN THE KAZAN AREA. Date of information

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REFERENCE POINT:

Kazan RR Station, Yards and Shops, Main, BE No [REDACTED]  
55°46'56"N - 49°06'15"E.

LOCATION:

11.5 nm northwest of reference point.

FUNCTION:

One of a group of sites deployed for the defense of Kazan.

SITE STATUS:

Probably complete but not operational at time of photography.

LAUNCH FACILITIES:

Six launch revetments with no launchers emplaced.

MISSILES:

None visible.

ELECTRONICS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT:

None visible.

COMMUNICATIONS:

One probable communications antenna located in support area.

OVERHEAD POWER and/or COMMUNICATION LINE:

Overhead wire line leads to site.

TRANSPORTING EQUIPMENT:

None visible.

SUPPORT AREA:

Structures

Other features include one probable storage bunker 35 by 20 feet located in operations area.

SECURITY:

Irregular-shaped security fence encloses site.  
Security fence encloses operations area.  
One possible guard tower.

REMARKS:

Site is situated on relatively flat terrain adjacent to a forested area.  
There is no evidence of activity at the site. Heavy snow blankets the installation.  
A SAM support facility 15 nm to the southeast serves the site.
