REQUIREMENT RR/HTA/G/S4/57: Confirm or deny existence of reported railroad running eastward from Nakhodka along the coast, possibly as far north as Ol'ga.

REMARKS: 25X1A

[redacted] photography shows no railroad running from Nakhodka eastward along the coast. The only railroad in the vicinity of Nakhodka is the line running north to Suchan.

Although the entire coast between Nakhodka and Ol'ga is not covered by recent photography, there is no evidence of railroads in or between the coastal towns of Valentin and Ol'ga shown as under construction on the AMS Map Series N504.
