

A suspect SAM site, constructed since the is located on level, open terrain




FIGURE 1, SUSPECT SAM SITE, MUSTVEE, USSR

4.8 nm west of Mustvee, 52.5 nm SW of Narva, and 5.0 nm west of Chudskoye Ozero (Peipus Lake). The suspect site is served by an allweather road and consists of an unsecured support area and a double-fenced, H-shaped suspect launch area. There is a centrally located, revetted, possible guidance position measuring 200 by 100 feet (Figure 1, Item 1). C-shaped revetments on either side of the road that forms the bar of the H enclose the possible guidance position in which there is one possible vehicle.

The four road termini, which are suspect launch positions (Item 2), are flared, unrevetted, and form a square 575 feet on a side. The positions appear unoccupied. A possible trailer, and a short, splayed tower are located on a short spur road adjacent to the road termini. A small revetted possible structure (Item 3) is located on the access road. No cabling is evident.

Outside the security fences is a possible gatehouse and a small vehicle hardstand. The support area (Item 4) contains one large building, 135 by 45 feet, and three small buildings.
