This rail-served and secured military installation with billeting facilities for 1,462 troops (based on 50 sq ft of floor space per man) is located 0.6 miles north-northwest of Dzhulfa. It covers approximately 40 acres and contains 18 buildings as shown in the tabulation.

A 1,300 by 700 ft motor vehicle park is located in the northern part of the installation. A 7,000 by 4,000 ft probable infantry tactical firing course northeast of the barracks area contains an ammunition storage area consisting of one bunker of undetermined size and one 90 by 45 ft revetted building (4,050 sq ft). Numerous trenches and foxholes through-

out the area are visible on TALENT photography of but are not visible on small-scale REYHOLE photography.
