


FIGURE 1. LOCATION MAP.

Saratov Airframe Plant No 292 (BE No is located at 51-29-57N 045-57-09E in the southwest section of Saratov, USSR (Figure 1). The plant is connected by taxiway to Saratov Airfield South 0.5 nautical miles to the south, and is also served by major roads and rail spurs.

Saratov Airframe Plant No 292 was first

observed on TALENT Mission

(Figure 2). At that time the plant contained approximately 2,006,275 square feet of floorspace. A comparison of this photography with that from KEYHOLE

(Figure 3), reveals additions

(Figure 3), reveals additions amounting to approximately 532,550 square feet of floorspace.



Saratov Airfield South, which serves the plant as a test and flyaway field, has two northeast/southwest runways: one, measuring 5,700 by 260 feet, is surfaced with concrete, and the other, measuring approximately 3,200 by 230 feet, is possibly of pierced steel planking or graded earth. The facilities at the airfield consist of one hangar, a checkout building, shops, fueling facilities, and support buildings, and have not changed since

The U-shaped earth revetment previously reported 1/ as containing two possible test cells is now identified as an aircraft test revetment with two aprons, two blast deflectors, and a control building.

On TALENT photography of 25 FLASHLIGHT, 3 CAB, and one CREEK were observed at Saratov Airfield South, but on KEYHOLE photography of only one CAB and one small possible straight-wing aircraft were discernible.
