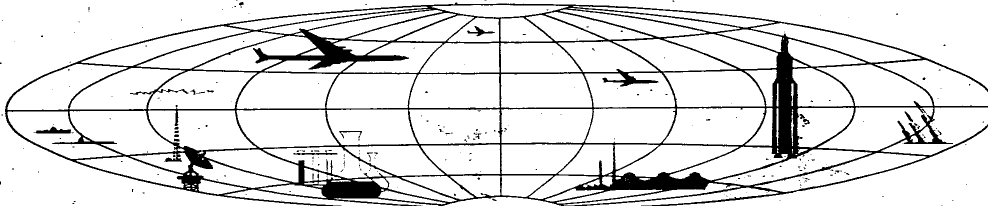

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training area or courses, (S) special training facilities, (I) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.

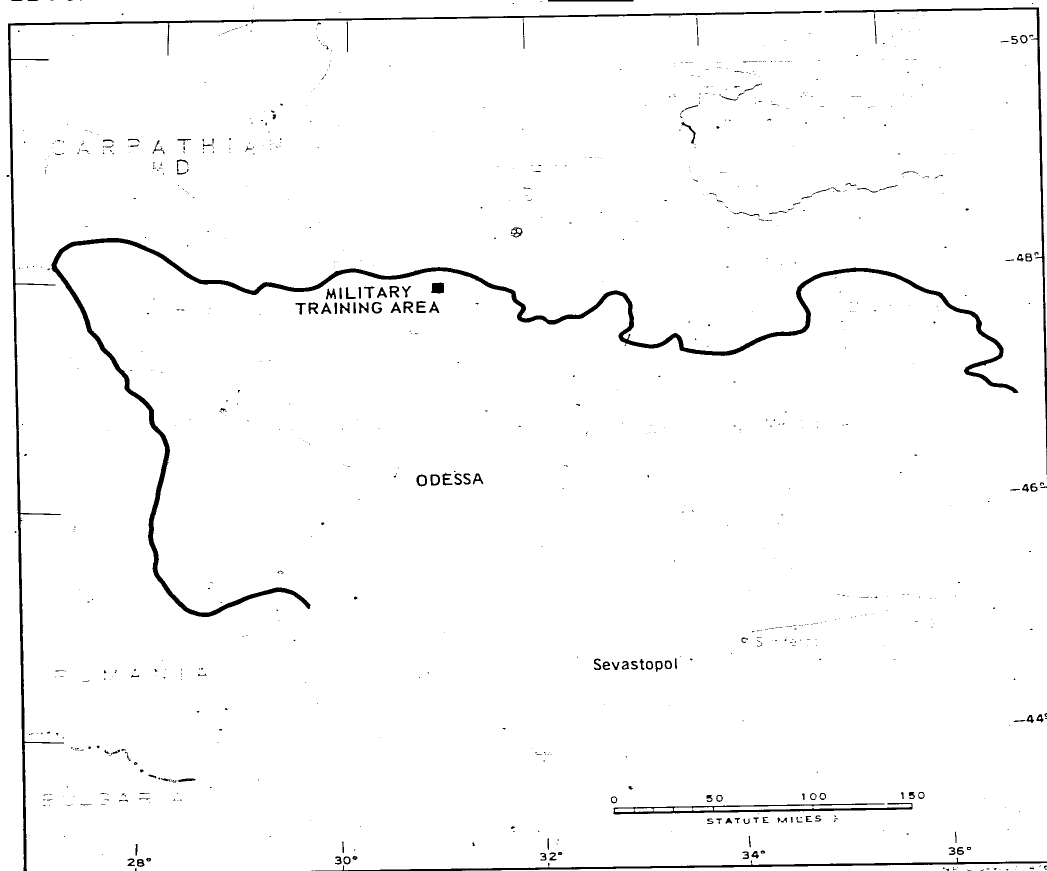


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF MILITARY TRAINING AREA.

SUMMARY

25X1D

A military training area is located 10 kilometers southeast of Pervomaysk along the Yuzhnyy Bug River (Figure 1).

The training area covers approximately 3,000 acres and contains an administration building, 4 barracks/administration buildings, 3 barracks, 4 storage buildings, 30 support buildings, a small-arms firing range, numerous

personnel trenches and artillery positions, and a probable vehicle park (Figure 2).

The installation was covered on KEYHOLE missions between [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] No significant change was observed during this period. Moderate activity was observed on all coverage.

Road Service

All-weather roads provide access to Pervomaysk and Grushevka.

Administration and Troop Housing Areas

Area D1 contains 4 barracks/administration buildings, 4 storage buildings, and 27 support buildings.

Area D2 contains an administration building, 3 barracks, and 3 support buildings.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains a probable vehicle park measuring 660 by 520 feet. Heavy trackage

was observed in this area on [REDACTED] coverage.

Small-Arms Firing Range

Area L is a small-arms firing range, 440 feet long and 35 feet wide.

Artillery Emplacements (Batteries)

Numerous field artillery firing positions are scattered throughout the training area.

Infantry Field Training

Numerous personnel trenches are scattered throughout the training area.
