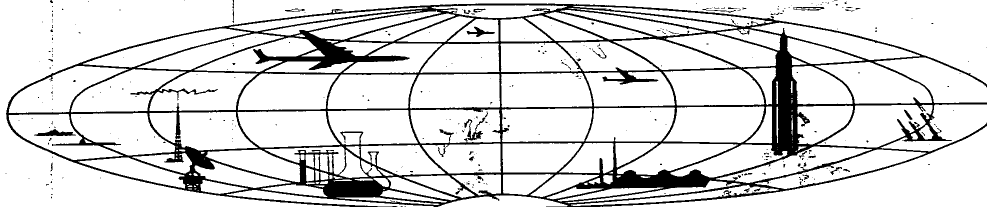
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#### PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1a (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the Production Center 1P1a.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (I) equipment storage maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (U) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.

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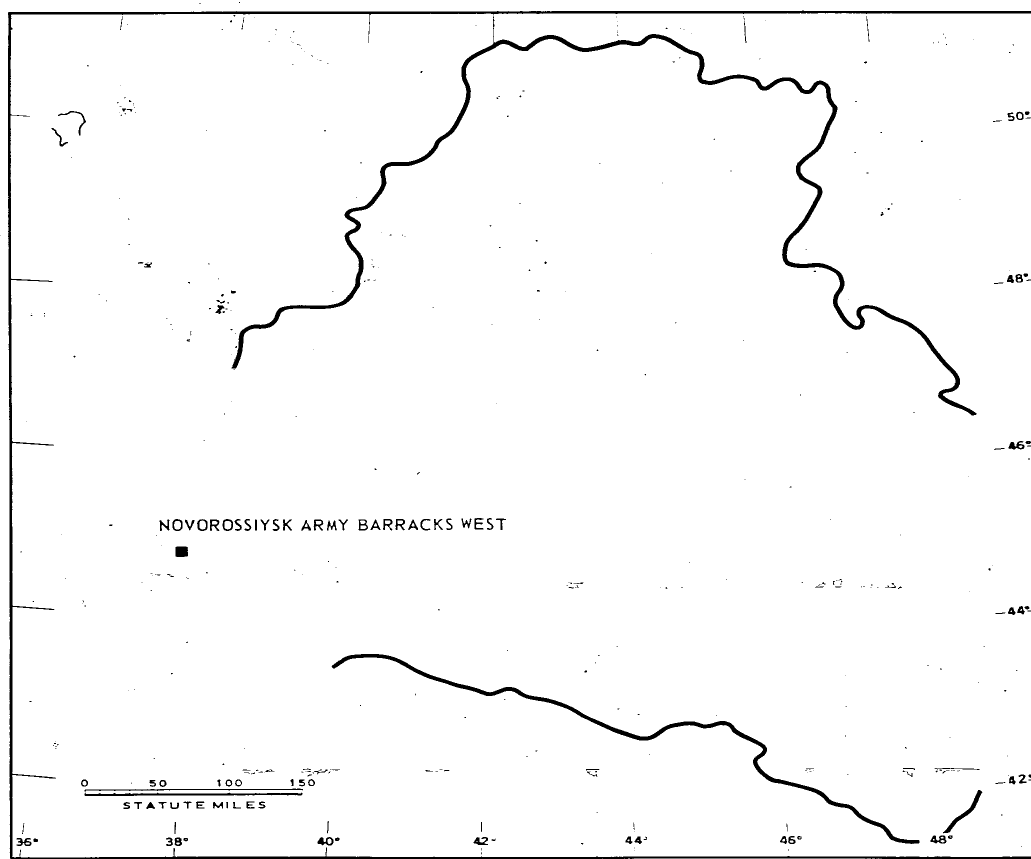


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF NOVOROSSIYSK ARMY BARRACKS WEST.

SUMMARY

Novorossiysk Army Barracks West is located on the west edge of Novorossiysk, 3.8 kilometers (km) west of the largest mole in the harbor (Figure 1). The installation covers approximately 780 acres and contains 2 administration buildings, 4 administration buildings, barracks, 75 barracks, 8 storage buildings, 24 explosives storage buildings, 6 possible storage buildings, 1 probable receiving administration building, 3 security buildings, 17 maintenance sheds, 61 support buildings, 23 probable family quarters, and 2 motor parks (Figures 2 and 3).

The TDI indicates that the Novorossiysk Headquarters 73rd Motorized Rifle Division [redacted] is located at 44-43-48N 037-45-03E which falls within the vicinity of this installation. It is possible that the motorized division could be housed at the Army Barracks; however, this could not be determined on this photography.

Between [redacted] KEYHOLE missions covered this installation. A comparison reveals no significant change.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

A single rail spur is 1.3 km northeast of the installation.

Road Service

The installation has access to city streets.

Administration and Troop Housing Areas

Area D1 contains 2 L-shaped multistory administration buildings, 4 U-shaped multistory administration buildings barracks, 24 multistory barracks, 30 single-story barracks, and 26 support buildings.

Area D2 contains 23 probable family quarters.

Area D3 contains 21 single-story barracks.

General Storage Area

Area E contains 8 storage buildings.

Ammunition Storage Areas

Area F1 contains twenty-four 90- by 30-foot explosives storage buildings.

Area F2 contains 1 probable receiving administration building.

Area F3 contains 1 main security building.

Area F4 contains 1 security buildings.

Area F5 contains 1 security building.

POL Storage Area

Novorossiysk Petroleum Products Storage No 4 [redacted] is 3.1 km north.

Other Buildings

Area H is an unidentified secured area with 6 possible storage buildings.

Equipment Storage Maintenance Areas

Area J1 contains fourteen 230- by 60-foot maintenance sheds, 24 support buildings, and one 300- by 290-foot motor park.

Area J2 contains three 150- by 40-foot maintenance sheds, 11 support buildings, and one 600- by 500-foot motor park.
