

A probable army barracks installation is located 2 kilometers southeast of the Maykop Road Bridge over the Belaya River (Figure 1).

This installation covers approximately 35 acres and contains 8 probable barracks, 2 probable barracks/administration buildings, a probable vehicle maintenance building, 8 probable storage buildings, 6 probable support buildings,

a secured open storage area, and 2 athletic fields (Figures 2 and 3).

Administration and Troop Housing Area


