

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage 'maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.

SUMMARY 25X1D

Krasnodar Army Barracks North is located approximately 5.3 kilometers (km)north-northeast of the Krasnodar Railroad Bridge over the Kuban River It is centrally situated in the city of Krasnodar within 4 km of other army installations (Figure 1).

The installation covers approximately 38 acres and contains 23 buildings including 5 probable barracks, 6 general storage, 2 probable security, and 10 miscellaneous support. The entire installation is surrounded by a fence




FIGURE 3. KRASNODAR ARMY BARRACKS NORTH. Sketch compiled from

(Figures 2 and 3).

KEYHOLE missions of fair quality photography covered the area between Comparative analysis reveals that 2 miscellaneous support buildings have been constructed in an internally fenced area between

Road Service

The area has access to city streets.

Administration and Troop Housing Areas

Area D1 contains 2 probable security buildings, an E-shaped probable barracks, a U-shaped probable barracks, 3 general storage buildings, and 8 miscellaneous support buildings.

Area D2 contains 3 probable barracks (2 constructed during the general storage buildings, and 2 miscellaneous support buildings.

Athletic Fields

Area K1 is an exercise area and Area K2 is an athletic/parade field.
