

SUMMARY

Sevastopol Training Area Southwest is located 4.5 kilometers (km) southwest of the center of Sevastopol (Figure 1).

The training area covers approximately 2,130 acres and contains an administration building, 7 barracks, 9 storage buildings, 2 vehicle sheds, a possible POL tank, a small-arms firing range, 2 wheeled-vehicle driver-training courses, a possible graded-earth landing strip, two 6-gun AAA sites, 20 support buildings, and 2 athletic fields (Figures 2).

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Road Service

1 Secondary, probable all-weather roads provide access to Sevastopol.

Aircraft Landing Strip

Area C, in the central part of the training area, contains a 1,900- by 310-foot possible graded-earth landing strip.

Administrative and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains an administration building, 7 barracks, 2 storage buildings, and 13 support buildings.

General Storage Area

Area E contains 7 storage buildings, a vehicle shed (250 by 30 feet), and 6 support buildings.

POL Storage Area

A possible POL tank, approximately 30 feet in diameter, is located in Area E.

Other Buildings

Area H contains a support building.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains a vehicle shed, approximately 220 by 45 feet.

Athletic Fields

Areas K1 and K2 are athletic fields.

Small-Arms Firing Range

Area L is a small-arms firing range, 310 feet long and 30 feet wide. $\dot{}$

Driver-Training Areas

Area Ml is a wheeled-vehicle drivertraining area. Three closed-circuit courses and 2 figure-8 courses are visible on photography of
