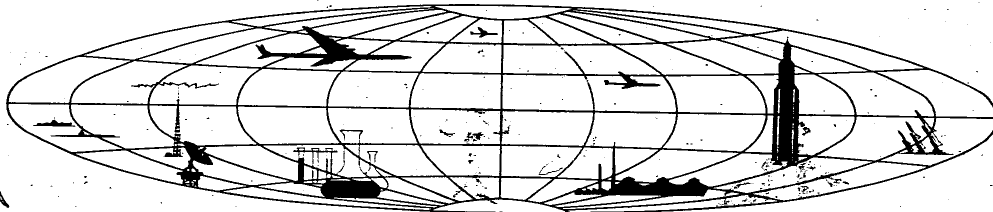

PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.

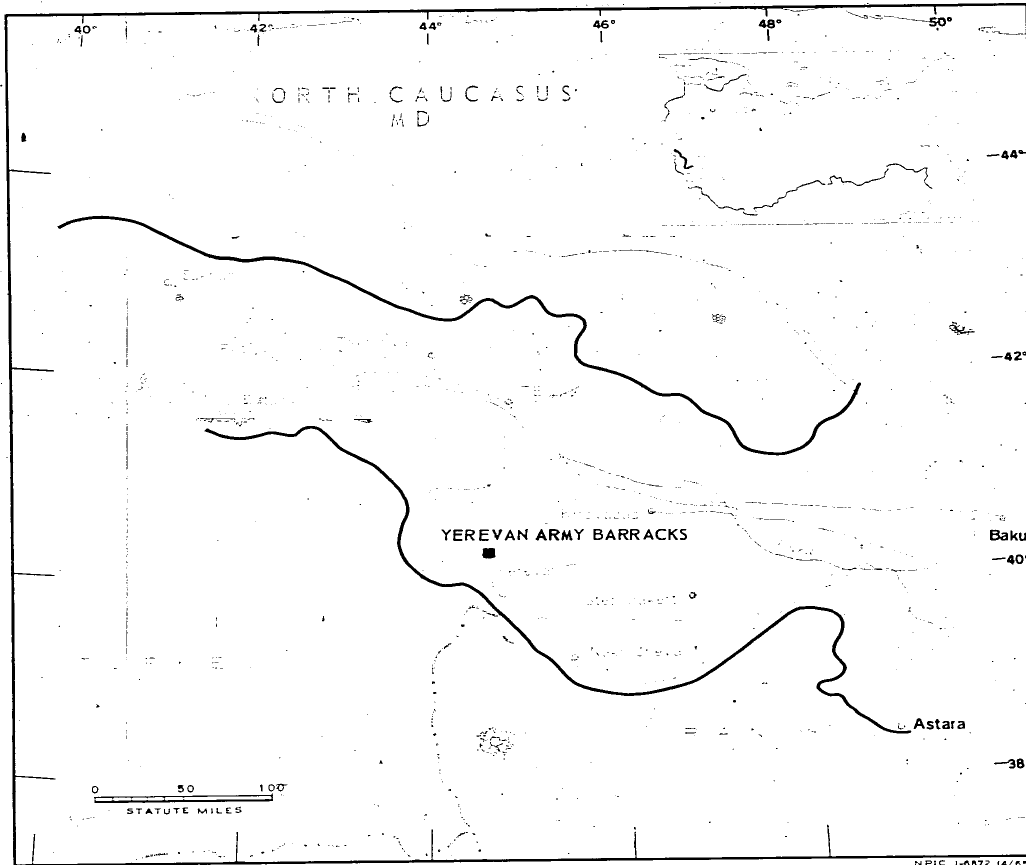


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF YEREVAN ARMY BARRACKS.

SUMMARY

Yerevan Army Barracks is located on the northeast edge of Yerevan (Figure 1). It covers approximately 90 acres and contains 13 barracks, 4 administration buildings, 12 vehicle/maintenance sheds, 14 warehouses, and

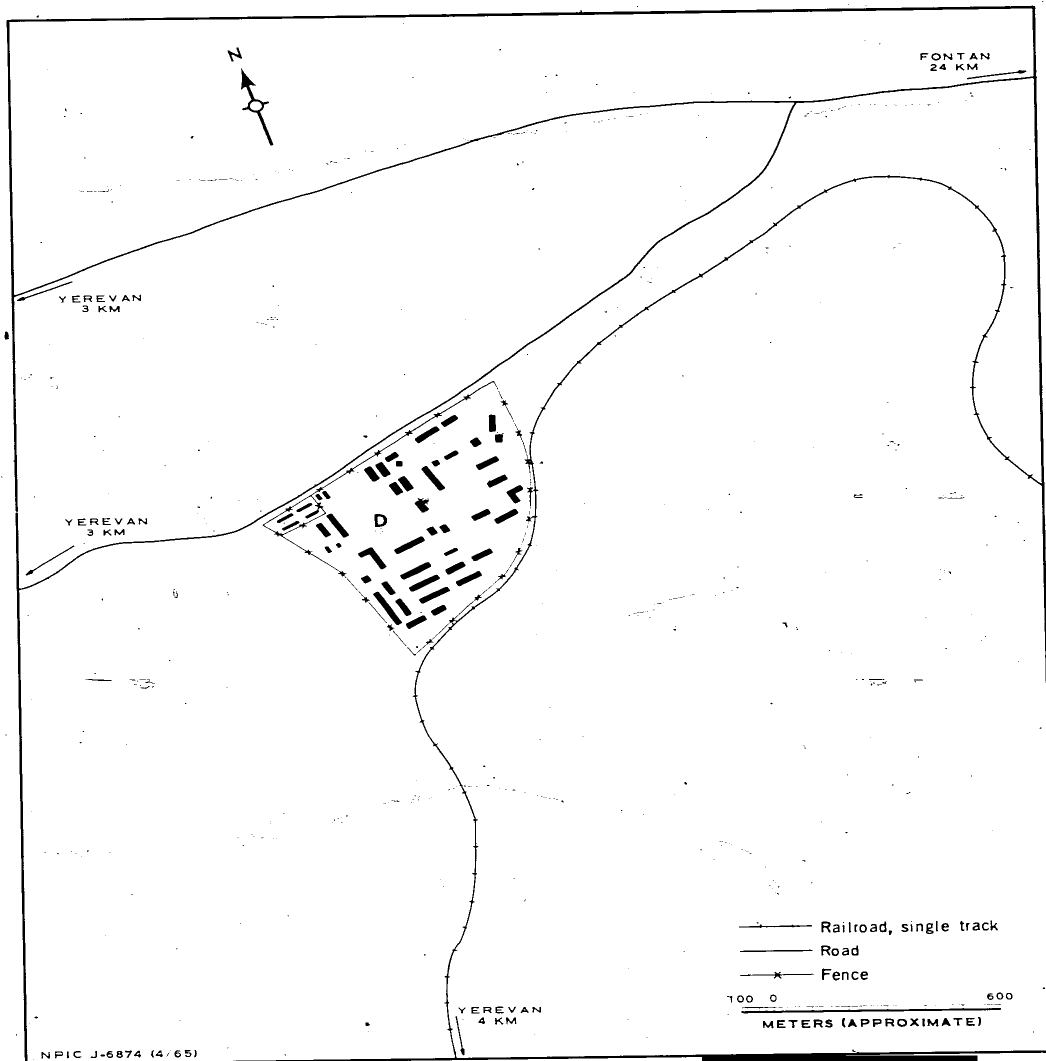


FIGURE 3. YEREVAN ARMY BARRACKS. Sketch compiled from

4 support buildings (Figures 2 and 3). : [REDACTED] TALENT and [REDACTED] KEYHOLE missions between [REDACTED] covered the barracks. There were no significant changes.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

A single-track railroad serving Yerevan extends north and south of the barracks area.

Road Service

A primary road extends east and west of the installation and joins the main road to Yerevan.

Aircraft Landing Strips

There are three airfields in the vicinity of the barracks area: 8 kilometers (km) north

is Yerevan/Yegvard Airfield, Yerevan/Parakan Airfield is 16 km southwest, and Yerevan Airfield is 12 km southeast.

Administrative and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains 13 barracks, 4 administration buildings, 12 vehicle/maintenance sheds, 14 storage buildings, and 4 support buildings.
