


FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF SAMARKAND ARMY BARRACKS NW.

Samarkand Army Barracks NW is located in the west-northwest part of Samarkand (Figure 1).




FIGURE 3. SAMARKAND ARMY BARRACKS NW. Sketch compiled from

The installation covers approximately 30 acres and contains 2 probable barracks/administration buildings, 3 probable barracks, 8 barracks, 2 storage buildings, 5 probable storage buildings, 7 probable vehicle sheds, 17 support

buildings, and a probable parade field (Figures 2 and 3).

The area was covered on KEYHOLE missions between No changes to the facilities were observed, and a light level of activity was observed on all coverage.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Road Service

The installation is served by the Samarkand streets.

Administration and Troop Housing Areas

Area Dl, secured by a wall, contains 2 multistory, U-shaped probable barracks/administration buildings, 3 multistory probable barracks, and 13 support buildings.

Area D2, secured by a wall, contains 8

multistory barracks, 5 probable storage buildings, and a support building.

Equipment Storage/Maintenance Area

Area J contains 7 probable vehicle sheds (two 360 by 35 feet, two 325 by 35 feet, two 250 by 40 feet, and one 400 by 40 feet), 2 storage buildings, and 3 support buildings.

Athletic Field

Area K is a probable parade field.
