The feature under consideration appears as a rectangular grid on the photography. However, this is due to the fore-shortening effect produced by the long-focal length, low-oblique, aerial view. It actually is more nearly square in shape.

The size of the grid is about 1900' to 2100' in an East-West direction and 1800' to 2000' in a North-South direction. This makes the smaller internal subdivisions about 1000' by 190' each.

Straight line distances to the grid from two locations are as follows:

- a) From Nishi Notoro - about 1.7 miles.
- b) From Honto - about 46.5 miles.

The road from Honto to Shiramushi is shown on the A.M.S. 1:50,000 map (1943) as "improved". From Shiramushi to the grid (about 4.6 miles) it is shown as a "track or trail". In the area covered by the photography it appears as a passable and used unimproved road.

The geographic coordinates of the grid are approximately $45^{\circ}55'45''$ N and $142^{\circ}04'30''$ E.

Attached is a sketch of the area, based on the A.M.S. 1:50,000 map with the feature located.
